eTranscript Legislation

AB1056 (Fong) – Requires all CCC's to convert to electronic transcripts.

CCCCO has received one time funding of \$500,000 from the legislature to disburse

Mini Grants

- \$5000.00 to each college to do any of the following...
 - ☑ Send and receive transcripts
 - ☑ Respond to electronic requests for transcripts
 - ✓ Import transcripts into campus systems (SIS, Degree Audit, Planner, etc.)

One college may apply for multiple grants

A district may apply for multiple colleges

You may apply even if you've had a previous mini grant

97 colleges applied

So far we've paid out \$110,000 to 15 Colleges

Work must be completed by 6/30/2013

Based on surveys we are expecting to pay out 40 more mini-grants totaling \$200,000

There's plenty left...go for it! ©

California Transcript Data Standard

To qualify for a mini grant colleges must use

- Supports CSU-GE, CSU-IGETC, UC-IGETC, and SB1440 data elements via...
 - CCC ASCII the standard for sending transcripts via eTranscript California incorporates all elements and is the simplest method.
 - PESC XML CA elements are supported via an approved UDE (User Defined Extension)
 - EDI CA elements are formatted in specific segments




